SAILING CHARTER SERVICES

RULES OF CONDUCT

CUSTOMER/GUEST BEHAVIOR: Guests are expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner. Inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated. Any behavior determined by the Captain or Crew to be inappropriate (i.e. argumentative or lewd or offensive language or gesture(s), unsafe activity, intoxication, or any form of harassment, etc.) may result in a non-refundable, early termination of your Charter without refund and possible notification to law enforcement.

NO SMOKING: All charters are NON-SMOKING. Use of any tobacco, THC or CBD products, cigars, pipes, cigarettes, e-cigarettes, vapor devices, etc. are STRICTLY prohibited. Use or possession of any of these products may result in a non-refundable, early termination of your charter and the assessment of cleaning fees.

CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL: Guests may bring and consume alcoholic beverages within moderation and legal limits of applicable state law jurisdiction. The Captain or Crew may impose additional restrictions on alcohol consumption especially if any guest is suspected of becoming intoxicated – this is for everyone’s safety and wellbeing – we are not operating a “booze cruise”!

CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES: While alcohol is allowed in moderation, smoking or vaping of any substance is NOT allowed; marijuana (medical or recreational) in ANY form is NOT allowed; possession or use of any psychoactive or psychotropic substances onboard is NOT allowed.

MOVING ABOUT: Your safety is of the utmost concern and priority. It is important to maintain your balance and have a firm grip on an appropriate hand-hold. No one is allowed outside the cockpit (i.e. forward deck) without permission of the Captain. Guests are free to go below deck but must hold on and maintain their balance to avoid injury.

SWIMMING: Swimming may be permitted and is AT YOUR OWN RISK. Swimming is an optional Charter activity and is at the Captain's discretion. If swimming is permitted by the Captain, every passenger will follow ALL rules, orders, requirements or restrictions provided by the Captain or Crew. NO ONE LEAVES THE BOAT WITHOUT EXPRESS PERMISSION OF THE CAPTAIN!

FOOD AND BEVERAGE: Prepared food, snacks and beverages may be brought and consumed onboard - refer to our "Restrictions on Use of Equipment and Facilities" Policy. In the event of any spilled food or beverage, notify the Captain or Crew member and promptly clean up as instructed. A garbage bin/bag is located in each bathroom and in the galley. Only liquids are allowed in sink drains. You are expected to clean up after yourself otherwise a cleaning fee may be imposed.

SEASICKNESS/MOTION SICKNESS: Any person that experiences seasickness MUST remain on deck. The cabin area below deck is NOT an appropriate place for any person to deal with seasickness. This may seem counterintuitive – trust us, we've done this before!
