SAILING CHARTER SERVICES

USE OF EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES

EQUIPMENT: Any and all navigation equipment, electronics, or mechanical equipment is strictly OFF LIMITS and must NOT be tampered with or touched unless permitted by the Captain.

Equipment of this type includes but is not limited to: windows/hatches, helm, steering wheel, engine, transmission, batteries, solar arrays, electronic navigation, gages, pumps, electrical wiring, electrical outlets, switches/buttons, smoke detectors, emergency equipment, navigation desk, engine throttle, compass, VHF radio, satellite communication equipment, Starlink Wifi/Internet, USB chargers, installed Blue Tooth devices, fans, compartments/closets/drawers/bins/bags and contents therein, winches, lines/ropes, sails, blocks/pulleys, or any other apparatus. Fire Extinguishers are for emergency use only in case of fire.

ENTERTAINMENT SYSTEMS: The Captain and Crew are responsible for all entertainment systems and may provide instruction on their use while underway. Entertainment systems include: Stereo system, television, volume controls, installed Blue Tooth devices, and Starlink WiFi/Internet.

BATHROOMS/HEAD: All sinks and showers have hot and cold water (in moderation). Only human waste and marine toilet paper is to be disposed of in the marine toilet. DO NOT dispose of any foreign objects such as sanitary products, wipes, paper towels, tissues, or any other items in the toilet. The plumbing system is NOT the same as your home and can easily clog or be damaged if not used properly. Follow the flushing instructions provided on the underside of the toilet seat – if you require assistance, please ask a Crew Member (we promise to be discrete). Use a necessary amount of toilet paper but not in excess. Ensure the toilet is flushed thoroughly after each use according to the instructions. Failure to operate the toilet properly may damage equipment and cause a disgusting mess resulting in additional fees. Don't forget to wash your hands.

GALLEY/KITCHEN: The onboard galley stove and cooking appliances are NOT for use by guests. The onboard sinks are ONLY for biodegradable liquids and NOT to be used for food prep disposal nor for disposing of any unwanted items. None of the sinks have garbage disposals. Please DO NOT treat our sinks like you treat your kitchen sink - they are NOT the same. The refrigerator/freezer, microwave, tea kettle, coffee pot, dishes and utensils may be used with permission/assistance of our Captain or Crew but may be limited in their use due to weather or sea-state.

STATEROOMS/BEDROOMS: Use of these rooms for changing clothes is permissible. The beds and linens are for the Captain and Crew – NOT for guests to use for sleeping, resting, or any other activity other than privacy to change clothes or freshen up, if necessary, unless pre-approved by the Captain.
